

AMENDMENT I

TO

OAKHILL ESTATES HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION INC.

BY-LAWS AND STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES

August 8, 2002

In accordance with the procedures established in the Associations Covenants and By-laws, the following additions, deletions, changes and/or modifications have been made. These changes address issues that have arisen since the last Homeowners meetings, and other items that the Board of Directors deem important enough to publish.

ADDITIONS

ARTICLE III Section 4, Subparagraph D

Two new subsections have been added. These Subsections read as follows:

(3) Architectural Control of the Community.

Once a month, the ACC either as a whole or as individuals, will drive through the neighborhood to ensure that Community standards are being met. The Committee will then convene a meeting during which time notes will be compared, transgressions identified, and a list of violators will be compiled. Letters will be sent to each of the violators identified, in accordance with the procedures outlined in these By-laws. Each letter shall, at a minimum, identify, the infraction (s) noted, time period in which to remedy the problem (s) noted, and points of contacts for clarification.

(4) Fines.

Starting on the fifteenth day (15th) after expiration of the grace period, a fine of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) per day will be assessed. Rights to appeal this fine and the findings of the ACC are identified in Article IV, Section 6 of this document.
